## **End of Year Reward Trips**

As part of our Achievement and Reward programme we are proposing to take all pupils who have complied with our Expectations for Learning on a **Reward Trip** on **Friday 13 July 2018**. This year we are offering a number of different venues so your child has a choice of where they would like to go. They can only choose **ONE** trip from the following:

**Drayton Manor Park, Tamworth** costing £25.00. This trip will depart from school at 8.40 am and return at approximately 19.30 pm.

West Midlands Safari Park, Kidderminster costing £23.00. This trip will depart from school at 8.40 am and return at approximately 18.45 pm.

Cinema and Bowling, Great Park costing £19.00. This trip will depart from school at 8.40 am and return at approximately 4.00 pm. Please Note: Lunch for students attending this trip will be provided.

Malvern Hills, Worcester costing £12.00. This trip will depart from school at 8.40 am and return at approximately 4.00pm. Ideal for those students who prefer a serene day walk with beautiful views of the Malvern Hills.

PLEASE NOTE: All of these trips have **limited spaces** and will be sold on a **first come first serve basis**. Payments are **non-refundable** and must be made online via ParentPay by **no later than Monday 4 June 2018.** Once payment has been made, no alterations can be made to your choice of venue.

It is **essential** that all payment deadlines are adhered to; any students that have not paid by this date will not be permitted to participate in this trip. Deadlines are set to ensure the school can make payments to the organising company in advance of the trip taking place. Payment also signifies parental permission for the pupil to attend the trip. If your child is eligible for the Pupil Premium we may be able to help meet part of the cost of this trip. If financial help is required, please contact Mrs Dickerson via the usual school number.

During trips and visits members of the public often comment on the good behaviour of our pupils and how much of an ambassador they are to the school. However, if your child fails to meet the school's Expectations for Learning, displays unacceptable behaviour in or out of school or shows a poor attitude towards staff, the privilege of attending may be revoked at any time at the Head teacher's discretion. No refund of any monies paid will be made.

Unless stated, your child will require either a packed lunch or money to purchase food whilst on the trip. If your child is entitled to a free school meal and you wish a lunch to be provided, please order this with Miss T Smith. Pupils will **not** need to wear school uniform. For all trips pupils should dress appropriately for the weather on that day, ie bring a waterproof coat or suncream, a hat and plenty of water if it is hot and sunny.

Pupils who have exceeded the amount of penalties will be expected to attend school as normal.
