End of Term Non-Uniform Days: Friday 21 December 2018, Friday 12 April 2019 and Friday 19 July 2019

As we are a cashless school, we are now collecting the of end of term non-uniform contributions via ParentPay. This is now available to pay via ParentPay and is to be paid by Friday 14 December.

The amount is still **£1.00 per pupil, per non-uniform day** so we are asking for a contribution of **£3.00** to cover all **3 non-uniform days** as detailed above. If you wish, you can donate more (up to £5.00) by editing the amount in the payment box on ParentPay. If you do not pay, your child will need to attend school on these days wearing full school uniform.

Please note: Year 11s will have left school by the end of Summer term so they will only need to pay a **minimum of £2.00**. It is expected that most of **Year 10** will be on Work Experience at the end of Summer Term so they will only need to pay a **minimum of £2.00**. Those Year 10 pupils who do not secure a Work Experience place and are in school on the last day of Summer Term will be asked to pay £1.00 during that week.

The money raised from these days is donated to charity and the charities that we are supporting in 2018/2019 are:

Smiling Hearts (SHAC) is a charity school set up for disadvantaged children living in Cambodia. The school has 104 students (28 are orphans and 4 are HIV positive) all of whom live in a small commune in Siem Reap.

Halt Heartache is a local campaign/charity which has been formed recently with the objective of reducing the number of road deaths and injuries amongst youngsters in Birmingham. One of the founders of Halt Heartache is a parent of one of the four young men from our school who tragically lost their lives in a road traffic accident in 2009 so we feel it is particularly fitting that we support this initiative. Some pupils from our School Council will also be involved in generating ideas for this campaign.

St Basils is a charity that supports young homeless people (aged 16-25) in Birmingham.

Motivation Charitable Trust is a charity that provides wheelchairs for disabled people living in the developing world.
