**Subject: Early Closure – Wednesday 24 June & Thursday 25 June 2026**

Dear Parents and Carers,

Due to the current weather conditions, we will be closing the school early at **1:30pm today (Wednesday 24 June) and tomorrow (Thursday 25 June)**.

This decision was taken this morning after carefully assessing the school site to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all pupils and staff. Whilst classrooms are manageable at present, the build-up of temperature throughout the day means that too many classrooms become unsuitable for effective and safe learning once temperatures rise in the afternoon.

Students who do not have prior permission to leave the school site in emergency situations will remain in school until the end of the normal school day, where appropriate supervision will be provided.

For pupils who travel to and from school on organised transport, parents will be contacted directly regarding arrangements. If you do not hear from us, please contact the school office as soon as you can.

If your home circumstances have changed and you now need your child to remain in school, please contact the school office as a matter of urgency, clearly stating your child's name and form group.

The situation will continue to be monitored closely. **At present, we expect the school to be open as normal on Friday, with the usual finish time of 2:45pm.**

The uniform adaptations previously communicated will remain in place for the rest of this week. Pupils may choose to wear their school PE kit and/or their uniform.

We continue to encourage pupils to bring plenty of water to school and ensure they re-fill bottles at break-time. Free water is also available in the canteen every day. Breaktime will be extended today to enable all pupils to get lunch. The canteen will also be open when we dismiss at 1:30pm for any pupils who wish to get food at that time. Free school meal entitlement can be used at any time of the day.

The Year 10 exams scheduled for this afternoon and tomorrow afternoon have been moved to earlier in the day.

Whilst we appreciate parents may have concerns about the hot weather and decisions around whether we remain open or we close, we must emphasise that decisions are made based on safety, and pupils are expected to attend

during the times the school is open. We will only ever make the decision to close after careful consideration of all relevant factors.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to commend our pupils for their conduct during the hot weather this week. Their maturity and resilience have been truly impressive and reflect the values we strive to instil, helping them to grow into successful and happy individuals.
