- 6. The Committee will meet when required, but at least once a term.
- 7. The clerk to the committee is Andy Poulton.
- 8. The duties of the Clerk are:

- 9. If the Clerk fails to attend a meeting, the Committee may appoint any one of their number to act as Clerk for the purposes of that meeting.

- 11. Minutes of the meetings shall be presented to the next available meeting of the Full Governing Body.

## **Terms of Reference**

  - RE and Collective Workshop and Sex and Relationships policies
  - Consider and monitor policies and performance data on Behaviour, Attendance and Punctuality
  - safeguarding policy and arrangements
  - educational visits
- 2. Establish a mechanism for recommending approval to the Governing Body on matters relating to pastoral and curriculum issues. These will include, but are not restricted to:
  - Year 9 options
  - Curriculum development
  - Assessment for learning
  - Pastoral roles
  - More and Most Able
  - E-learning
  - Homework Policy
