'Worldskills UK'- Friday 22nd November 2019

Your child has been invited to the 'Worldskills UK' event which takes place at the NEC, Birmingham. This event is a partnership between businesses, education and Governments that accelerates young people's careers giving them the best start in work and life. This show aims to inspire and transform lives through a series of interactive events, changing the way we think about careers, skills, training and apprenticeships.

The details are as follows:

<u>Purpose:</u> To encounter experts within employment, colleges, universities and training providers. To 'try out' new skills and challenges. To gain valuable knowledge and be inspired by the people they meet. To gain free, impartial, up to date guidance in making suitable, informed career choices for the future.

<u>Transport and timings</u>: The group of Year 11 pupils will meet in the school canteen at 9.55am and leave school, along with members of staff at 10:15am. We will travel by coach, supplied by Kings Norton coaches. After our session we will meet at 2.10pm to depart on the coach and return outside Hall Green Library at approximately 3pm.

Equipment: Pupils will need to bring their usual equipment and books for their period 1 and 2 lessons. They <u>MUST</u> wear their full school uniform. Cold lunches will be available for pupils to collect at 9:55am from the school canteen to take with them. Alternatively, they can buy lunch there, although they can be expensive and sometimes queues. We would recommend they bring a light waterproof coat for the walk to and from the car park in the case of rain.

As part of the organisation's security and safety measures on the day they may ask to scan your bag. Please note there is no charge for this trip. If you would prefer to not miss the time from school, it is also open on Saturday 23rd November 10am – 4pm.
