Hall Green School is an 11-16 Academy, co-educational and ethnically diverse. We are a popular and heavily oversubscribed institution, described by Ofsted (2019) as ‘a welcoming and inclusive school’ where ‘pupils are happy, and they achieve well’ and the ‘positive relationships between pupils and staff are a hallmark of the school’.

We are seeking a colleague to lead the following areas in the department:

- To raise standards of pupil attainment and achievement within ICT and Computing.
- To monitor and support pupil progress in ICT and Computing providing appropriate intervention.
- To be accountable for pupil progress within ICT and Computing.
- To ensure the provision of an appropriately broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum for pupils studying in the department.
- To be accountable for leading, managing and developing the ICT and Computing department.
- To deploy financial and physical resources within the department effectively to support the school and department development plans.
