
Guide for pupils on how to upload work to Class Charts and read their feedback



When you open your Class Charts, some, but not all, of the homework tasks will require a document to be uploaded.

This symbol indicates that you are expected to upload a piece of work.





When you open the homework, you will see a blue button for uploading attachments.

If the blue button is not there, then the teacher is not expecting you to upload work.

To upload work, click on the blue button.




