“Trust me” by Loudmouth Theatre Company. The following issues are addressed: Sexual health, consent, contraception, STIs and unplanned pregnancy. Pupils will watch the stage production and there will be questions for reflection and discussion at various points.

Contraception

Sexually-transmitted illnesses (STIs)

The dangers of pornography

The dangers of sexting

Body image and social media

All sessions on the Tuesday will be in single-sex groups. We will be delivering content which has become statutory in 2021 and all the staff leading the sessions are fully trained in this.
