Uniform

We have introduced the uniform card, now called the 'Ready, Respectful, Safe' card, which will help to reward those pupils who are always smart. For those pupils whose uniform, or behaviour standards outside of lessons, is not as we would expect, a mark is made on their card as a reminder of our expectations. Consequences are in place for multiple signatures.
