Dear Parent/Carer,

I hope you and your family have had a safe and enjoyable Christmas break.

As you will no doubt know from media reports, the government and the Department for Education have updated their guidance due to the Omicron variant. We have been monitoring the situation throughout the Christmas break with a view to reviewing our safety measures in school.

Largely thanks to our safety measures being strictly adhered to, the numbers of cases within school have been minimal throughout the autumn term. As we return in January, we will be introducing a few changes for the foreseeable future to be able to better understand the situation. We fully understand the impact these measures can have and will therefore keep them under constant review with a view to remove them as soon as we believe it is safe to do so. The government intend to review the measures on January 26 and we will follow any updated guidance at that point.

Changes from 4 January 2022

- Face masks (not snoods) to be worn in classrooms.
- Pupils to wear PE kit to school on PE days; this should be their full school PE kit and not general sports clothing. If they so desire, pupils may wear their uniform over the top. (Note, pupils only need trainers on Tuesday 4 and Wednesday 5 January and not their full kit.)
- People who are fully vaccinated or children/young people aged between 5 and 18 years and 6 months identified as a close contact of someone with Covid-19 should take an NHS rapid lateral flow test every day for seven days and continue to attend school as normal unless they have a positive test result.

Previous measures that will continue

- Face masks (not snoods) to be worn in communal areas. Pupils must bring their own mask to school.
- Hand sanitiser available in all classrooms and at various points around school.
- Spray disinfectant available in all rooms for pupils and staff to clean down desks if desired.
- Indoor spaces well ventilated with windows and doors open where possible; coats may continue to be worn in classrooms if needed.
- Pupils and staff to test twice weekly at home. LFD kits issued regularly to pupils.
