## **Membership and Conduct**

1. Membership is currently five Trustees and three Associate Members. The current members are:

2. Membership will include the Headteacher.

- 3. The Committee shall invite such other persons to attend meetings as may be desirable and necessary.
- 4. The Chair of the Committee will be a Governor member. The Committee will elect the Chair annually.
- 5. Quorum will be three Governors.
- 6. The Committee will meet when required, but at least once a term.
- 7. The clerk to the committee is Katie Hedges.
- 8. The duties of the Clerk are:
  - To convene meetings
  - To attend meetings and take minutes.
- 9. If the Clerk fails to attend a meeting, the Committee may appoint any one of their number to act as Clerk for the purposes of that meeting.
- 10. Minutes of the meeting, after initial approval by the Chair, shall be sent to members within 7 days of the meeting.
- 11. Minutes of the meetings shall be presented to the next available meeting of the Full Governing Body.

### **Terms of Reference**

- 1. Provide an opportunity for discussion on pastoral and curriculum issues. These will include:
  - consider and monitor progress against the School Development Plan;
  - approve and monitor the school's systems for assessment and tracking of pupils;
  - receive and discuss reports on the provision of Special Educational Needs;
  - to maintain an overview of all related school policies and ensure their regular reappraisal;
  - consider and monitor impact of the school Curriculum, including PSHE and SMSC;
  - consider and monitor the RE and Sex and Relationships policies;
  - consider and monitor policies and performance data on Behaviour, Attendance and Punctuality;
  - consider and monitor the safeguarding policy and arrangements;
  - consider and monitor the educational visits policy and arrangements.
- 2. Establish a mechanism for recommending approval to the Governing Body on matters relating to pastoral and curriculum issues. These will include, but are not restricted to:
  - Year 9 options
  - Curriculum development
  - Assessment for learning
  - Pastoral roles
  - E-learning
  - Homework Policy.
