Dear Parent/Carer,

I am sorry to inform you that a well-respected and very long-standing member of our staff, Ms Wright, died in hospital this week after a short illness.

Pupils have been informed via assemblies this morning. Children will react in different ways and experience different feelings such as sadness and curiosity. These reactions are all normal. We have an educational psychologist in school today to support any pupils that need any specialist help with their emotions. Pupils have been encouraged to speak with staff and/or visit the welfare office if they need to. Over the coming days, we will continue to put support in for those that may need it.

Ms Wright worked at the school for 35 years and has been a teacher for 50 years. She has given the school and education as a whole incredible service, always wanting the best for the children in her care. Ms Wright started at the school as a Science teacher and progressed to Head of Shire House. This academic year, she was Head of Year 7 in the autumn term when we switched to the horizontal system. Ms Wright was so very proud of pupils in Shire house, her year group, and all those she taught.

I know many families will have known Ms Wright over a very long period with several generations coming through the school. She will be remembered with great fondness by the whole school community and we will be considering how we can celebrate her life and her contributions to the school in due course.
