Dear Parent/Carer,

As we enter the final week of term, I would like to thank all parents/carers for their support throughout this year. Our aim at Hall Green School is to provide the best opportunities possible for all of our pupils in order to help them thrive. This work is done very much in partnership with families and we appreciate your support.

Last week of term arrangements:

Monday:

- Year 8 Science Fair (normal timetable for all year groups).
- Year 10 P1&2 college workshops, normal lessons for the rest of the day.
- **Dress code – normal uniform for all**

Tuesday:

- Year 9 and Year 7 to all wear full PE kit all day, as they will be participating in Sports Day. **PE kit all day (bring equipment as usual)**
- Year 10 P1&2 College workshops, normal lessons for the rest of the day.
- **Years 8 & 10: uniform**

Wednesday:

- **All pupils to wear PE kit** with an option of a white T-Shirt.
- Year 8 Sports Day P1&2
- Year 10 P1&2 College workshops, normal lessons P3 & 4
- P5 - All years to participate in the Colour Run (sponsored event, communicated via Classcharts with parental opt out option).
- Year 9 and 10, dismissal at 2.35 pm
- Year 7 and 8 dismissal at usual time of 3.15 pm.

Thursday:

- Off site trips or in school enrichment activities including: Escape rooms, cricket coaching, animal demonstration, pizza making, films, badminton.
- All pupils may wear **non-school uniform or PE kit**; those in school **must wear/bring trainers**
- Dismissal for those in school at 2.45 pm.

Friday:

- **Non-uniform day**
- Dismissal at 12.05 pm
